I would like to personally invite all of you to attend a special concert featuring our own Symphony Band in concert with the Tuebingen Music School Band on Wednesday, May 14th, at 7:30 pm in Pioneer's Schreiber Auditorium. If you are not aware, Tuebingen is Ann Arbor's sister city in Germany. They have hosted the Pioneer

Symphony Band (on tour in 2006), the Pioneer Symphony Orchestra (on tour in 1992) and the Community Jazz program numerous times. It's our turn!!! In addition to hosting them in concert, we are also requesting that we provide home stays for a few days. If you are interested in hosting a student from Tuebingen for a few days in May please contact Gloria Wilson.

Audition results will be posted at Pioneer and a copy will be sent to Tappan and Slauson Middle Schools the first week of May. I will post Concert Band and Symphony Band only. If your child's name does not appear on either list, you child has been placed in Varsity Band.

Band Camp is right around the corner! Camp is August 12th through the 18th, with all-Band registration taking place on the 11th. If your child is a member of either Concert of Symphony Band they are expected to attend Band Camp. If your child is a member of the Varsity Band, Band Camp availability is on a "first come first serve" basis with basic instrumentation being considered as a criteria.

Finally, the Bands of Ann Arbor are trying something new and exciting this Picnic Pops! Instead of each middle school performing, there will be two feeder "All-Star" bands! The West-Side and East-Side All Star feeder Bands will be conducted by All Three of Ann Arbor's comprehensive High School directors! Yes you read correctly, all three. For the West Side, I will conduct one selection, and (introducing) Mr. Jason Smith, Director of Bands @ Skyline High School, will conduct the other selection! The East Side will feature Steve Roberts (Huron High School Director of Bands) and again Jason Smith each conducting one selection. Please join all of us as we celebrate one of Ann Arbor Public Schools greatest concert treasures Picnic Pops for fun, food, and Fantastic Music!

Please remember to keep donating, purchasing, and working at the shop.

The NYC trip may be over, but there is always another summer of band camp around the corner or the next trip to prepare for.

Signing up to work is easy. Stop by the shop and sign up in the notebook in the volunteer area. Shifts are 2 hours in length and you can sign up for 2 shifts per week. The shifts are available on a "rolling calendar", which means the shifts for the following month will be available to sign up for. Every Monday a new week becomes available, so if you have a particular day/time you would like to work, stop in early on a Monday for the best selection of shifts!

Also, the first 4 hours you work in each school year goes to support the General Band program (4 hours per family, for those with multiple students). Any hours worked after that are applied to the camp/trip/etc. of your choice. With over 300 students in the band program, there is the potential to earn \$5000.00 for the band program if every family worked just one shift during the school year. Tired of candy sales?

Come and work a shift at the Thrift Shop-you might like it!

The last payout occurred on March 1st and a grand total of \$6,712 was earned by band members and their families.

The next payout will be September 1st.
